

2020 First Tee Omaha Parent/Child Programming Procedures

Parents: We look forward to spending time with your child this summer while honing their golf games and emphasizing “life skills” to each of them. The safety of everyone and having fun—are our top priorities!

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WEATHER: “Pop-up” on our website: thefirstteeomaha.org will identify any programming weather delays, postponements or cancellations!

Prior to check-in/pick-up:

- Please remain in your car or practice “social distancing” at all times while on-site
- **It is your responsibility to provide a Water Bottle for your child—prominently identified**
- Help us by ensuring your child has gone to the bathroom just prior to the start of programming
- **Upon completion:**
 - Students will turn-in any equipment borrowed & utilize hand sanitizer before they depart
 - A coach will walk their students to the North corner of the parking lot at Pacific Springs or near the clubhouse at Platteview and will wait until each child has been picked-up by parent/guardian.

Check-in: We will supply: Clubs, Masks, Hand Sanitizer, Thermometer; Waivers to sign at initial session

- We have identified 15 minutes prior to your child’s scheduled start to:
 - First day of each session---if you haven’t previously; read & sign WAIVERS necessary
 - Thermometer on hand if, in doubt—ALL coaches will be checked daily
- We will supply a Mask on the initial day of programming and in the possession of the child for the duration of the entire programming session—WE recommend each child to wear a Mask
- Parents; please adhere to social distancing

Social Distancing: is our priority throughout each programming day!

- It will start upon your arrival, through the day and until you depart
- Each station will be set up with a cone or spots marked that are 6ft away from the hitting area for students to wait behind similar to our safety zones in the past
- Encourage students not to touch each other or their equipment/things
- Only using foot fives, elbow fives or waves

Equipment/ Supplies: “Rule of Thumb” TOUCH ONLY YOURS-- NOBODY ELSESES!

Students will carry all their clubs to each station -depending upon age—could ONLY be putter & short iron

- We supply clubs to students and will check-out for the day or entire session—returned at the end; based upon our inventory
 - We will clean/sanitize each club as needed and at the end of day
 - You’re welcome to utilize your own club---please make sure you can identify
- Golf Balls
 - Coaches will use a Bag snag to pick up golf balls so students will not have to touch them
 - We will have wipes out for coaches to wipe down the Bag Snag handles

Coaches: Will wear masks any time they’re around students; thermometer check-daily; ALERT if they show symptoms

- Ensure enjoyment and safety of each child
- To start the day, coaches will pick-up students by the sidewalk leading up to the practice area

- Use hand sanitizer after touching golf balls/ shared equipment/ each group of students/ end and start of the day
- When giving instruction on the golf swing, they will maintain appropriate social distance and modeling behavior, giving verbal cues while avoiding touching a participant or their equipment
